CAN LIVE OAK CHURCH BE AN ACTS 2 CHURCH?

Can Live Oak Church be an Acts 2 Church? This was once a question I wondered about when my family and I first started attending Church here in 2003. I thought it was a good question at the time and a legitimate one at that. In fact, as a husband approaching 8 years of marriage and a father of 3 very young, vibrant children, I was definitely seeking, praying and hoping to find an Acts 2 Church within driving distance of our home in Walker, Louisiana. Could Livingston Parish provide us with such a Church? I found this to be another good question that was weighing heavily on my mind...

I was raised in the Catholic faith until I was 11 years old. About that time, I spent the night with a friend named "Gabe" on a Saturday night, and his mom offered for Sunday to take me to their Church, take me to lunch afterwards and then take me home. It sounded like a wonderful plan to me, but of course, I had to bounce it off of my dad first. When I did finally build up the courage to ask him, he agreed without hesitation, and I was ecstatic! I guess he figured he might as well have the weekend off from having to punish me for embarrassing him and disrupting Catholic mass! Either way, I went into this particular weekend anticipating some wonderful things.

Well, I assure you Gabe's Church was no disappointment! It was a happening place for sure. They sure did invest in their children's ministry there too. I had the best time, and I walked out of there with one mission, and the mission was clear - to get my parents to start bringing us to Church there! If I remember the timing right, it took about a month or so, but eventually my parents finally caved, and I was never punished for acting up in Church again. What was interesting is, at this point, we were no longer "Catholic" but instead, "Non-Denominational." This was fine by me. All I knew at the time was that we were going to Gabe's Church. Not only was I enjoying a slice of heaven on earth (may I remind you I'm only 11), but my parents and sister were enjoying themselves too. This was my first experience attending a true, Acts 2 Church.



So what in the world is an Acts 2 Church? As Bro. Mark would say, "I'm so glad that you asked!" Well, we have to turn in our Bibles to Acts chapter 2 to find out.

Acts Chapter 2 : 42 – 47 (NIV) says:

"They devoted themselves to the apostle's teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. All the believers were together and had everything in common. They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved."

Since birth and the original change from the Catholic Church we were attending to a Non-

Denominational Church, I have belonged to a handful of other Churches throughout my life. I can honestly say there has been no comparison to Live Oak Church. My family and I have been a part of Live Oak Church since some of our best friends, Darren and Shannon Donze, invited us to visit during Vacation Bible School. After agreeing to the invite, we came cautiously, not realizing that our lives would be changed forever. Since our arrival on that first Sunday evening in July of 2003, our lives have been transformed by the Word of the living God, by our relationship with our Savior Jesus Christ, by the renovation work of the Holy Spirit, by the preaching and teaching of Dr. Mark Crosby, and by the special relationships formed with various church members - our brothers and sisters in Christ. Due to the traumatic experience of the COVID-19 virus for me and my family last year, and the tornadic-like path of destruction it left behind on our lives, we had desperate needs, and our family, our friends and the people at Live Oak Church stepped in and rescued us. This Church has proven itself to be a true and Godly, Acts chapter two Church.

By reading these verses in Acts Chapter 2, does that help clarify? These Scriptures describe what a true and Godly church really is, and Live Oak Church meets the bar. It fulfills the criteria. What can I say? My church family is truly amazing! I mean really, truly amazing! I had spent a month in the hospital with an additional three months of recovery at home. I had not worked for my two jobs for more than three months, and I am the bread-winner for our family of five. In addition, not only did we have our regular monthly bills piling up, but the medical bills started pouring in, along with insurance premiums I had usually paid from payroll deduction through my paychecks. Although I had short term and long term disability, I had not started the paperwork until mid-October after I was discharged and finally home from the hospital. Neither Stephanie nor I could have anticipated all of these things happening the way they unfolded. Starting the paperwork is better late than never, but it took three to four weeks to process the application according to the company representatives. We were lucky to have everything submitted, and we were able to start receiving benefits Thanksgiving week.

With so many devastating factors in play, the odds were stacked up against us, but the good Lord was at work, and our brothers and sisters in Christ went into action to pray for us, to feed us and to supplement us financially until other money would start coming in. Stephanie and I reflected on these blessings so many times during the timespan. It was so nice to be caught in the safety net of Almighty God! He had everything arranged, and we never had any stress in the various areas of our lives that we would normally have stressed over, even though our savings was depleted after the first six weeks of paying our bills. We were guessing that God knew how stressed we were on the medical side of things that He protected us in all of the other areas knowing our weaknesses and limitations.

Since I have been back in action, one of my missions has been to work on developing the CARE TEAM at Live Oak Church. With each given month that the Lord blesses us with ministry, we have all sorts of needs that arise with our parishioners in our Church on any given day. I am working with Kelli Nolan to organize a group of volunteers to help "Care" for our parishioners. If you have a gift of compassion, hospitality and care for others, please consider joining us in this ministry. Currently we are seeking volunteers to visit, make phone calls, write cards, cook and deliver meals to our parishioners in need. If you are interested in participating, please email me your name, email, phone number and the areas you would like to serve.

Finally, a prayer of Thanksgiving for Brother Sam. He did well with his open heart surgery. Please continue to pray for healing.




