

THE PROMISE OF EASTER BY STEPHEN HEBERT

just love this time of the year, don't you? I find it so awesome when the surrounding scenery awakens from its winter sleep, when the March downpours move along, and the bright warm southern sun reaches out to touch us letting us know summer is near. This is the time of year when it's socially acceptable to break out the nice bright colors in your wardrobe, and you trade in your darker earthy colors for the pastels and paisleys that light up a room. For many others, this is the time of year when they think about those they've lost in their lives, and

waves of sorrow pass through with one wave crashing after another. The best part about this is, in return for the sorrow, we get to celebrate the promise of Easter, and we remember this glorious day in the history of all humanity.

What is the promise of Easter you may ask? It is the promise that Jesus made at the entrance of the tomb of his good friend, Lazarus, when He said, "I am the resurrection, and I am life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies..."

Death seems so cruel to us, so unfair and final. This is exactly how the disciples felt after seeing Jesus tortured and then executed

by being nailed to a cross. After Jesus died, for three days the disciples were crushed. They were mourning, and they had fallen into a deep pit of despair, not even considering the promises that Jesus had made previously.

The Apostle Paul explains this in 1st Corinthians 15:54 - 56, "Death has been swallowed up in victory. Where, O death is your victory? Where O death is your sting? The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ."

Whether you have lost a loved one or friend within the last few months or it has been in the years past, the empty spot in your heart is right where this special person (or people) fit. In return for this pain and this empty spot in your heart, I want to encourage you today to do three things:

1st Pray – Pray that the Lord will heal your wounded

2nd Stand firm - The Apostle Paul continues in verse 58 saying, "Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain." 3rd Remember - Don't forget Jesus' promise! Don't forget that first Easter and the empty grave!!

The promise of Easter and the resurrection of Jesus shows us that death is not the end. Instead death is merely a transition point from this life to the next as we continue in eternity. Just as Jesus promised in John 11:25 - 26, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies, and whoever lives and believes in me will never die." For believers, the promise of Easter is eternal life with our family, with our friends, and with the Lord Jesus forever and ever, Amen.

ome 64 years or so ago, the Scouting Program began at Live Oak United Methodist Church. These programs have been an integral part of our church community. We currently charter BSA Troop 58, Venturing Crew 58, and Pack 58.

Scouting teaches basic developmental life skills that are grounded in a duty to God, as well as duty to country and fellow man. Scouting works in conjunction with the church, encouraging leadership, fellowship, community, and FUN. The mission of the Boy Scouts of America is to prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetimes by instilling in them the values of the Scout Oath and Scout Law.

The troop enjoys many activities such as camping, canoeing, hiking, and others. They earn merit badges which opens the door to a number of career opportunities as well as teaching them basic skills such as swimming, cooking, first aid, personal management, and many, many others.

The Venturing Crew is a co-ed group and follows the BSA guidelines, working in similar manner as the troop. A scout can earn ranks

within the Venturing Crew - even Eagle, the highest rank offered by Scouting.

The Cub Scouts start everything. They are family oriented and the activities are geared for families to work together. Cub Scouts go camping, attend day camp, build pinewood derby cars and race them, and many other activities - all as a family.

Thus far, in the 64 years, Troop 58 and Venturing Crew 58 are happy to say that several scouts have earned their Eagle. Many of these are still active with the church.

With all of this being said, no doubt you may have heard of the recent events that have had an adverse effect on the programs. Because of these events, Scouting at Live Oak UMC is at a crossroads. Membership in all areas has dwindled to the point that if things do not turn around soon, we will no longer be able to offer these wonderful opportunities in the very near future.
